

Insite eAlerts | *The Insite Online Banking eAlerts system will send customized account alerts to your customers on balances, transactions, and activity. The alerts will be sent to an email address or wireless device.*

Easily Customizable

The alerts are setup and managed by the customer on the online banking site. Each message can be formatted by bank administrators using a customizable template. The template administration and reports are included on the online banking administration site.

The eAlerts system is integrated with your existing online banking system. No additional hardware will need to be purchased. In addition to the email or text messages, the alerts will also be available to the customer within the secure messaging inbox on the online banking site.

Available Alerts:

Statement: Notifies you if a new statement is available online (no more sending out email messages when statements cycle)

Low Balance: Notifies you if your account balance falls below a threshold amount

High Balance: Notifies you if your account balance exceeds a threshold amount

Negative Balance: Notifies you if your account balance is negative

Check Posted: Notifies you when a specific check is posted

Deposit: Notifies you when funds are deposited to your account

Withdrawal: Notifies you when funds are withdrawn from your account

Principal Increase: Notifies you if the principal on a loan increases

Principal Decrease: Notifies you if the principal on a loan decreases

Loan Payment: Notifies you when a payment is made

Reorder Checks Reminder: Alerts you when it is time to request a new order of checks

Certificate Maturity: Notifies you when a certificate of deposit (CD) reaches maturity

Loan Payment Due: Notifies you when a loan payment is due

Insite eAlerts Features

- ✓ Customers and bank employees can use the eAlerts to send and receive secure messages
- ✓ The eAlerts report on the administration site will list every alert that was sent out
- ✓ Your customers create and manage their own eAlerts
- ✓ eAlerts settings allow bank administrators to edit eAlerts templates sent to customers in the form of e-mail messages
